The journey began when **Smt. Pratibha Mukherjee**, the then **Hon'ble Minister of State, Public Works Department, Government of West Bengal**, laid the foundation stone on **July 2, 1970**. Years later, it was through the unwavering commitment of **Dr. Motahar Hossain** that the dream was finally realized with the official establishment of the college in **1985**. Affiliation from the University of Burdwan followed in **1989**, cementing its academic legitimacy.

The celebration successfully connected cultural heritage with environmental responsibility, emphasizing the importance of **protecting Mother Earth** as a part of national devotion.



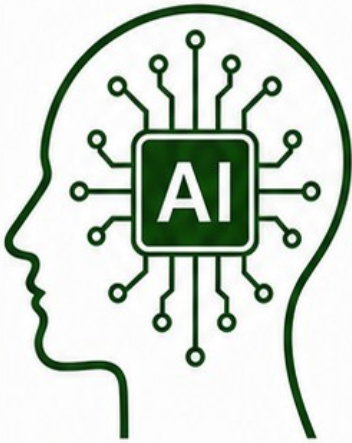
